

CASE STUDIES



Barton Manor School, Canterbury

Funded by the Department for Education, the scope for this project was to construct a brand new school in the heart of Canterbury, Kent, on the former Chaucer Technology site that boasted state-of-the-art facilities, including a sports block, a multi-use games area, and beautifully landscaped grounds.

Working closely with the main contractor, Kier Construction, through our expertise, we ensured the project ran smoothly from start to finish, complied with building regulations, and adhered to relevant Building Bulletins. Following its successful completion, the school welcomed students in September 2022.



Ebbsfleet Green Primary School, Swanscombe

An £8.8m MMC school project in Ebbsfleet Garden City, a major development alongside the Thames estuary in North Kent, to support the growing community. The school was developed using 98 modular units, making it the largest modular build undertaken by Kier.

Harwood provided Building Control services and landscaping to ensure a smooth project execution, including preparing the site's foundations for the module's arrival and certifying Building Regulations compliance.
